Notes

The most common size for orotone images is $11" \times 14"$. Some prints exist in multiple sizes. In his 1919 introductory catalog of Curt-tone prints, Curtis listed four available sizes for the 33 different prints he was selling then: $8" \times 10"$ (\$10".00), $11" \times 14"$ (\$15.00), $11" \times 17"$ (\$30.00), and $18" \times 22"$ (\$50.00).

For consistency, we show the image titles in this list as they appeared in *The North American Indian* (if applicable). Some of these images have been sold in the past with slightly different titles.

The dates listed for the prints are the copyright dates for the images. Some images might have been created earlier than the copyright dates.

The *NAI* column lists, where applicable, the volume reference for the image as published in *The North American Indian*. The first number is the volume or portfolio, followed by the page or plate number for the image. All portfolio plate numbers begin with the letter "P."

Some orotone images do not appear in *The North American Indian*. Prints listed with a code of "NA" were not created *for The North American Indian* and do not appear in the publication. Those listed with a code of FOTG were published in *The Flute of the Gods*, a book published by Marah Ellis Ryan in 1909.

This list is provided for information purposes only. It should not be construed to be a definitive list or a reference for authentication purposes. Buyers should be aware that there may be forgeries, repaired or reproduction prints that are claimed to be original Curtis orotones. Always work with a reputable dealer when making an investment in a Curtis print of any kind.
